



Think Pawsitive UKI Trial Info & Class Schedule February 16 – 17, 2019

Building Opens: 7:45am **Briefing:** 8:45am **Walk Thru:** 8:45am **Judging begins:** 9:00am

Parking: There are plenty of parking spots available towards the front of the building or on the west side of the building. *No overnight parking will be allowed at the trial site. No RV's due to space limitations.*

Food: Food is not available on the site for purchase. There are various restaurants and fast food vendors within a very short driving distance. Breakfast items and lunch will be provided for workers.

Measuring Dogs will begin at 8:30am.

Measuring will take place near the secretary's table and exact times will be announced. You do not need to be measured before your first run if measuring has not yet happened. If you have not yet had a UKI measurement and your dog is jumping below the 22" Regular height or the 20" Select height, you must get your UKI measurement ASAP. Dogs competing above those heights do not need to be measured. If you have an actual measurement from another organization and wish to use this measurement, please bring your card to the measuring judge for documentation. If you find that you need to compete in another jump height due to your measurement, please see the show secretary for new scribe sheets in the classes that have not yet run.

Checking in at the ring.

All competitors in classes must sign in at the gate for each event by checking off their name on the gate sheet. If you do not check in, the class will not wait for you. Please only check in for the class being walked. Please remember it is your responsibility to be ready at the ring for your run. Your scribe sheet will be handed to you upon checking in to run. You will be in charge of this while you line up to run within your jump height. Please hand the scribe sheet to the gate steward as you enter the ring.

Move-ups & Jump Height Changes

If you collect enough points to move to the next level (Congratulations!), please see the trial secretary for new scribe sheets. You must compete in your new level the next competition day. All jump height changes will be accepted up until the first run of the day following dog measuring.

Not for Competition Runs

You may turn any run into an NFC run, but must declare this right before entering the ring. You may use a non-audible toy (NO food, NO clickers). You will only be given the course time for NFC runs. This includes training start lines. You **MUST** leave the ring immediately once time is up.

Late Entry Policy

All late entries will be charged at \$16 a run. UKI numbers for both dog and handler must be provided or an additional fee of \$2 per number will also be charged. You are responsible for putting the correct information on the scribe sheet or your result will be void. We are unable to swap entries from one dog to another or from one day to another. If this kind of change is needed then a late entry fee will be charged.

Masters Qualifier Information and Running Orders

UKI USA Open November 2019 Jacksonville, FL

The Masters Heat will start after the regular Agility classes are finished. The Masters Jumping will be run first and running orders will be posted and will be announced as posted. Handlers must run in strict running orders, failure to do so will result in elimination. Please disregard the running orders you are given on the competitor list. The Masters will run small to tall and a draw will be done at the show for running orders within the jump heights, but all day of entries will be run first within their jump height. Masters Agility will run in reverse order of the jumping heat result. For a full list of the rules please see the UKI Rules & Regulations and amended rules in the trial premium. We hope you will stick around and support those running in this new event. Winners of either the Agility or Jumping and the top 2 places in combined results in each jump height will be invited to participate in the Masters Final at the USA Open in November (details below). For those interested in WAO, you must run the Masters at your WAO jump height – details available at the UKI web page.

Helpers: Think Pawsitive LLC depends on volunteers to make this a great event. All workers must check in with the show help coordinator at the show site to receive their work assignment and must have a qualifying assigned job in order to be eligible for:

Trial Site Rules: Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds. *Please NO SPIKE SHOES OR HEELS on the turf. Please wear clean, athletic footwear to preserve the flooring!*

Online Results

Results will be available to view within 2 weeks of the trial. You will be able to log on to your account and see results that were clear rounds, gaining Level points.
