DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL SITE:

From Milwaukee:

Follow I-94 W

Take exit 297 for US-18/Barker Rd toward County Rd JJ/Bluemound Rd (0.3 mi)

Use any lane to turn left onto N Barker Rd (1.2 mi)

Slight right onto WI-59 W/W Greenfield Ave

Continue to follow WI-59 W (3.6 mi)

Use any lane to turn left onto WI-164 S/WI-59 W/East-Side Bypass/Les Paul Pkwy (0.5 mi)

Turn right onto Pearl St (0.1 mi)

Turn left onto Commerce St (0.1 mi) to **301 Commerce St, Waukesha, WI 53186**

WORKERS: We appreciate your help! For *each* class you work, you will receive a hole-punch on a Volunteer Voucher card that is worth \$2 towards future trials, workshops or classes.

RV's: There is no overnight RV parking at our facility. You may park there during the day and either go to the nearby Wal-Mart to park overnight or stay at the following RV park (with hook-ups) that is 10-15 minutes away from the facility:

From Madison:

Follow I-94 E

Take exit 297 to merge onto US-18 W/WI-164 S/E Moreland Blvd toward Waukesha (0.4 mi)

Follow WI-164 S to Commerce St (2.9 mi)

Merge onto US-18 W/WI-164 S/E Moreland Blvd (1.4 mi)

Use the left 2 lanes to turn left onto WI-164 S/East-Side Bypass/Les Paul Pkwy (1.3 mi)

Turn right onto Pearl St (0.1 mi)

Turn left onto Commerce St (0.1 mi) to **301 Commerce St, Waukesha, WI 53186**

GENERAL BRIEFING:

There will be no gathering at the trial.

JUDGE'S CLASS BRIEFINGS: Will be listed on each course map. If there are questions that need clarification, the judge will specify a location during walk-throughs to answer them at the respectable distance.

FOOD: There will be **NO FOOD OR BEVERAGES** provided onsite (including for workers).

CRATING: There will be **limited indoor crating in our Black Matted Training Room**. Correct social distancing will be marked on the floor. If you have a group of friends and are comfortable being closer, that is ok. Remember it is up to you to keep social distancing when catching up with friends, discussing the courses, etc. **Bring your own crates. There will be no public crates available.**

NEW COMPETITORS: We know trials can be overwhelming, especially in these times. **Think Pawsitive STAFF** are always available to answer questions or assist you in any way. **CPE** competitors are the best around, so if you can't find a Think Pawsitive staff member, ask anyone.

WALK-THROUGHS: Time limit on walk-throughs will be reduced to 4 minutes for each jump height group.

- **Levels 3, 4, 5, & C** will walk together. Jump heights 4", 8" and 12" will walk first and then jump heights 16", 20" and 24" will walk together. If the class is large, like FullHouse and Jackpot, the number of people will be decreased.
- **Levels 1&2** will walk together and depending on the number of handlers in those two groups, all jump heights may walk together.
- **All handlers** are required to provide their own masks, which are required during the walk-throughs.

CHECK IN: DO NOT check yourself in. The gate steward will call names while you are walking the course to check you in. **PLEASE DO NOT MOVE YOUR DOG ON THE GATE SHEET. WAIT UNTIL THE GATE STEWARD IS THERE TO REQUEST A CHANGE.**

MASKS: Masks are required whenever you are in the building. This includes during walk-throughs, while running courses and when judging. Please work with your dogs to make sure they are used to this new normal.

COURSE MAPS: Will be emailed to you the evening before each day of the trial (usually by 9:00 pm). Full sized course maps will be posted at the trial. Please respect personal space when viewing them.

RUNNING ORDERS: **Final running order and course maps will be posted to the Facebook Group each morning. They will also be posted in the building entry by Suite H for you to take pictures.**

There will be no seating OR GATHERING in front of the ring. This space is only for the dogs and handlers in the class that is running at the time. Seating is only allowed in the crating area and social distancing is required. Please bring your own chairs. Do not use any chairs that are the property of the Think Pawsitive. **We will be doing LIVE STREAM in THINK PAWSITIVE DECEMBER CPE 2020 Facebook Group, so join the group for results and to follow along with the trial flow!**

LINE UP FOR YOUR RUN: You will stage by entering through Suite G before your run. Please maintain 6-foot social distancing. The gate steward will be giving direction on when to move up the line and when to go in the ring. After your run, please leave the ring and exit through Suite H as quickly as you can without disturbing your dog.

LEASHES: Handlers have the option to put leashes in pockets or safety loop them around their waist or neck. If this option is chosen, the leash must be out of the dog's sight. If the dog plays with it during a run, it would be considered a toy. If the handler does not wish to carry the leash, it should be dropped in the basket at the start line and the leash runner will place the basket at the exit gate on a chair.

BATHROOMS: People exiting the bathroom have the right of way. Please step back and let them out. Remember to wear a mask.

MEASURING: Make sure your dog is entered in the correct height when you receive your confirmation. Official measuring will take place at this trial throughout the day prior to the dog's first run.

RESULTS: We realize this is important to everyone. To minimize contact with the books and people touching the papers, we will post the results on a wall near the crating area and in the trial Facebook Group. Results will be broken down into levels: Level 1, Level 2, Level 3, Level 4, Level 5 and Level C. We expect you to keep social distancing when viewing the posted results. The best plan would be to take a picture of the results and move on.

RIBBONS: Will be handed out. We will have an area set up with a staff member that will give you your ribbons and/or labels.

Your responsible social distancing, good hygiene in the bathrooms, covering coughs and sneezes and diligence in wearing your mask will help Think Pawsitive Dog Training continue to host safe and enjoyable trials.
