



## Think Pawsitive UKI Trial Info & Class Schedule January 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup>, 2021

**Building Opens: 8:00am   Briefing: 8:45am   Walk Thru: 8:45am   Judging begins: 9:00am**

- Crating and Building opens each day at 8:00am.
- NO Day of Show Entries will be accepted. Briefing at 8:45am.
- Walk Thru at 8:45am
- First dog on the line: 9:00 am
- Measuring will be at 8:30am each day.

**Parking:** There are plenty of parking spots available. *No overnight parking will be allowed at the trial site. No RV's due to space limitations.*

### **Measuring Dogs will begin at 8:30am.**

Measuring will take place near the secretary's table and exact times will be announced. You do not need to be measured before your first run if measuring has not yet happened. If you have not yet had a UKI measurement and your dog is jumping below the 22" Regular height or the 20" Select height, you must get your UKI measurement ASAP. Dogs competing above those heights do not need to be measured. If you have an actual measurement from another organization and wish to use this measurement, please bring your card to the measuring judge for documentation. If you find that you need to compete in another jump height due to your measurement, please see the show secretary for new scribe sheets in the classes that have not yet run.

### **Checking in at the ring.**

All competitors in classes must sign in at the gate for each event by checking off their name on the gate sheet. If you do not check in, the class will not wait for you. Please only check in for the class being walked. Please remember it is your responsibility to be ready at the ring for your run. Your scribe sheet will be handed to you upon checking in to run. You will be in charge of this while you line up to run within your jump height. Please hand the scribe sheet to the gate steward as you enter the ring.

### **Move-ups & Jump Height Changes**

If you collect enough points to move to the next level (Congratulations!), please see the trial secretary for new scribe sheets. You must compete in your new level the next competition day. All jump height changes will be accepted up until the first run of the day following dog measuring.

### **Not for Competition Runs**

You may turn any run into an NFC run, but must declare this right before entering the ring. You may use a non-audible toy (NO food, NO clickers). You will only be given the course time for NFC runs. This includes training start lines. You **MUST** leave the ring immediately once time is up.

**Late Entry Policy**

All late entries will be charged at \$16 a run. UKI numbers for both dog and handler must be provided or an additional fee of \$2 per number will also be charged. You are responsible for putting the correct information on the scribe sheet or your result will be void. We are unable to swap entries from one dog to another or from one day to another. If this kind of change is needed then a late entry fee will be charged.

**Trial Site Rules:** Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds. Please NO SPIKE SHOES OR HEELS on the turf. Please wear clean, athletic footwear to preserve the flooring!

**Online Results**

Results will be available to view within 2 weeks of the trial. You will be able to log on to your account and see results that were clear rounds, gaining Level points.

**From Milwaukee:**

Follow I-94 W  
Take exit 297 for US-18/Barker Rd toward County Rd JJ/Bluemound Rd (0.3 mi)  
Use any lane to turn left onto N Barker Rd (1.2 mi)  
Slight right onto WI-59 W/W Greenfield Ave  
Continue to follow WI-59 W (3.6 mi)  
Use any lane to turn left onto WI-164 S/WI-59 W/East-Side Bypass/Les Paul Pkwy (0.5 mi)  
Turn right onto Pearl St (0.1 mi)  
Turn left onto Commerce St (0.1 mi) to **301 Commerce St, Waukesha, WI 53186**

**From Madison:**

Follow I-94 E  
Take exit 297 to merge onto US-18 W/WI-164 S/E Moreland Blvd toward Waukesha (0.4 mi)  
Follow WI-164 S to Commerce St (2.9 mi)  
Merge onto US-18 W/WI-164 S/E Moreland Blvd (1.4 mi)  
Use the left 2 lanes to turn left onto WI-164 S/East-Side Bypass/Les Paul Pkwy (1.3 mi)  
Turn right onto Pearl St (0.1 mi)  
Turn left onto Commerce St (0.1 mi) to **301 Commerce St, Waukesha, WI 53186**

## Think Pawsitive Dog Training, LLC Event Protocol during COVID-19

1. The gate will be outside at the Suite G entry. Dog running and dog on deck will be inside. All competitors will enter the ring through Suite G and exit through Suite H. This is to keep everyone safe and maintain social distancing.
  2. Warm up jump will be located inside, adjacent to the turfed arena.
  3. Scores will be posted in a private Facebook group and updated throughout the trial.
  4. No guests or un-entered persons allowed on the premises.
  5. Dedicated workers and current workers are permitted in the building. Please don't touch the equipment unless you are a dedicated worker.
  6. There will be limited spectator (trial participates only) chairs available with wipes. Please wipe down the chair after your use. If a chair is not available, you may not be in the spectating area.
  7. Participant chairs are not permitted in the spectator area. We will only be parking in the front of the facility. There will be NO PARKING in the rear, reserved lot.
  8. Limited crating will be in the black-matted area. Please obey markers as to where to crate in order to maintain social distancing. It is recommended that you crate out of your car, weather permitting.
  9. There will be no hospitality (beverage and food will not be supplied or available to participants)
  10. Masks must be worn at all times on the premises with the following exception:
    - a. Exhibitors may choose to run without masks, but must enter and exit the ring with masks on (leash on – mask on). Exhibitor MUST keep their mask on their person.
    - b. Exhibitors must bring their own mask. Masks will be available for \$2.00.
7. Hand sanitizer and disinfectant will be available, but it is highly recommended that exhibitors bring their own.
8. The bathroom doors will be propped “open” to minimize touching of handles. Please maintain a six-foot distance while waiting in line to enter the bathrooms.
  9. A minimum of a six-foot distance should be used during all walk-throughs. Masks must be worn during walk-throughs.
  10. Upon entering the ring, leashes will be placed in a basket and the basket will be moved to the exit.
  11. Ribbons will be handed out in person at the end of the day.
  12. Let's all use common sense, remain vigilant, and enjoy getting back to what we love.
